1. RULES

- 1.1. The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in 'The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017–2020' (RRS), the Prescriptions of the RYA, the 2000 Class Association rules, this NOR and the Sailing Instructions in ascending order.
- 1.2. The organising authority will be UYC Ltd in conjunction with the 2000 Class Association.
- 1.3. Competitors should note that UYC Ltd operate the RYA Racing Charter and they will be expected to sail in compliance with the Charter.
- 1.4. All competitors are required to wear appropriate buoyancy aids at all times whilst on the water.
- 1.5. A one-turn penalty will replace the 'two-turns' penalty. This modifies Rule 44.
- 1.6. The Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats and participants may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The helm and/or the crew must be a 2000 Class Association member to be eligible to compete.
- 3.2. Entries should be made using the event entry form on the UYC website.
www.ullswateryachtclub.org – payment will be taken at registration on the day of the event.
- 3.3. Competitors, including support teams, coaches, instructors, rescue crews and immediate families, etc., shall consider themselves visitors/temporary members of UYC for the duration of the event. Visitors not directly connected with a boat entered into the event will be required to pay a temporary visitor fee.

4. FEES

- 4.1. Entry fees will be £35.00 per boat minus a £10.00 subsidy from the Laser 2000 class association leaving a balance of £25.00 for Class Association Entrants to pay. This is applicable to both visitors and UYC members.
- 4.2. Entries from helms under 18 years will be granted a further £5.00 discount.

5. OTHER FEES

- 5.1. Fees for visitor camping for the event are shown below:

Large Tent / Trailer Tent	£15.00 per night
Medium Tent	£11 per night
Small Tent	£7.50 per night
Motor Home / Camper Van	£20.00 per night
Large 3+ axle Motor Home	£25.00 per night

- 5.2. Cheques shall be made payable to 'Ullswater Yacht Club Ltd'; UYC also accepts Debit/Credit card payments. Refunds will be at the discretion of UYC and will only be given in the most exceptional circumstances.
- 5.3. As per terms of our LDNP licence no Caravans shall be permitted on site.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Registration will be in the Clubhouse on Friday evening from 18:00 to 20:00 and on the Saturday morning from 09:30 to 11:00.
- 6.2. Competitors briefing will be held at below the Race Office on Saturday at approx. 12:00 noon.

27th May	3 races with earliest start at 13:00, back to back
28th May	3 races with earliest start at 11:00, back to back

- 6.3. The warning signal for the last race on 28th May will be no later than 15:00.
- 6.4. The duration of each race will be approximately 45 minutes.
- 6.5. The number of races completed to constitute a series will be three.
- 6.6. A boat's series score where more than three races are completed is shown in the table below.
- 6.7. Scoring will be the low points scoring system of Appendix 'A'.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and on the UYC website.

9. VENUE

9.1. UYC is situated on the north east shore of the lake approximately two miles from Pooley Bridge on the Howtown Road.

10. COURSES

10.1. The fleet will sail a Windward/Leeward course.

11. PRIZES AND TROPHIES

11.1. Prizes and trophies will be awarded.

11.2. The prize giving will be held at the UYC Clubhouse on the final day, approximately one hour after the last boat finishes, subject to protests.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. INSURANCE

13.1. All competitors shall warrant that they are covered by adequate third party insurance cover of £2 million.

14. FURTHER INFORMATION

14.1. Refreshments will be available from the galley during the day.

14.2. Breakfasts will be available from 09:00 each day.

14.3. Friday evening meals MUST BE booked in advance by emailing rotary@balchins.co.uk . Provision of meals on the Friday evening will subject to enough orders being received.

14.4. Meals for Saturday evenings will also be available. Menus, and prices will be available 14 days before the event.
