



SUBSCRIPTION FEES AND DONATIONS FOR THE 2018 SEASON

Ullswater Yacht Club has adopted a mixture of Fees and Gift Aid Donations as shown below, on which as a Community Amateur Sports Club, it can reclaim tax. The Club relies on all members to contribute both fees and donations to generate the income necessary to fund its operation and development.

UYC requires deposits of £100, £50 or £25 with application forms for new Family, Single or Crewing members respectively, to be offset against first year subscription fees, with effect from 1st January 2018.

* Safety & Boat Site Fee is paid by all UYC boat owners, including in and out of port cruisers, dinghies and keelboats, to offset Site and Safety Boat costs.

Reflecting the differing size, amounts of space and resources required by boats of different sizes, and the additional constraints on the site space from our growing membership, from 2018 differential pricing will be introduced for different sized dinghies and keelboats.

There are two bands:

- **Band 1.** Dinghies & Keelboats up to 1.9m wide and/or up to 4.99m in length
- **Band 2.** Dinghies & Keelboats 1.91m wide and/or over 5m in length

Note: The size of the dinghies will be measured when they are packed as they usually would be for storage in the boat park.
