Reflecting the differing size, amounts of space and resources required by boats of different sizes, and the additional constraints on the site space from our growing membership, differential pricing will be applied to different sized dinghies and keelboats.

There are two bands:

- Band 1. Dinghies & Keelboats up to 1.9m wide and/or up to 4.99m in length
- Band 2. Dinghies & Keelboats 1.91m wide and/or over 5m in length

**Note:** The size of the dinghies will be measured when they are packed as they usually would be for storage in the boat park.
